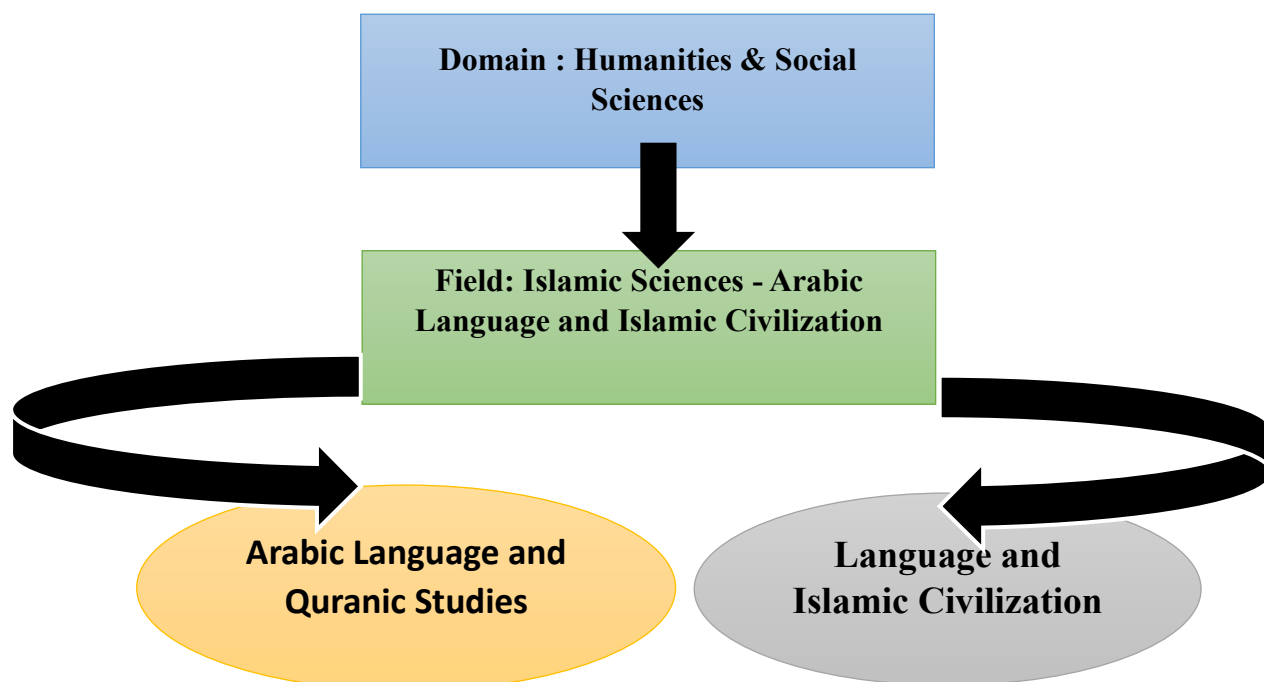

4 - Training content and its contexts:

Arabic Language and Quranic Studies is one of the branches of Islamic Sciences - Arabic Language and Islamic Civilization. This bachelor's degree program includes modules with content revolving around the Arabic language and its branches, such as grammar and conjugation, Arabic rhetoric, philology, prosody and rhyme, linguistic sources, techniques of written and oral expression, and pre-Islamic literature.
